August 9 is observed as International Day of the World's Indigenous People to promote and protect the rights of the world's indigenous population. The declaration was adopted by the UN General Assembly exactly ten years ago, the 13th of September 2007. The day marks the celebration of the diversity of the World's Indigenous Peoples and their cultures, customs and survival. In spite of the uniqueness of every ethnic group and the substantial differences among them, all indigenous peoples have a common problem: the protection of their rights. After centuries of oppression, genocide, colonisation and "exportation of cultures", the international community has recognised the need to

introduce special measures to protect their rights. Indigenous people are also called native people, first people, autochthonous people or aboriginal people. It is nice that considering indigenous people mostly face threats to their economical welfare, sovereignty and approach to their cultural resources, many international organizations like International Labor Organization, World Bank and the United States have set political rights for their welfare.

We come across around the world that there are many indigenous people cannot access the basic right to education. Their traditional methods of teaching, learning, and cultivating food are not always respected by education systems and teachers. Many indigenous people are struggling to preserve their knowledge and traditions. Traditional knowledge is passed down from generation to generation. Unfortunately, there are growing pressures to the environment and the ecosystems on which indigenous peoples depend.

According to the United Nations, traditional knowledge is "the knowledge, innovations, and practices of indigenous and local communities around the world." It is estimated that there are 370 million Indigenous people in around 90 countries across the globe. Many still practice their unique

customs and live culturally distinct lives from other citizens of their respective countries. The right to education for Indigenous people is protected in the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, which in Article 14 states that "Indigenous peoples have the right to establish and control their educational systems and institutions providing education in their own languages, in a manner appropriate to their cultural methods of teaching and learning."

Indigenous people cannot access important natural resources they used to enjoy, such as traditional foods and medicines, adequate water supply, game meat, and honey, due to excessive exploitations of the habitats. It is nice that there are many organizations around the globe are working to promote indigenous knowledge in the food system.

Let us commit to ensuring Indigenous peoples are not left behind as we pursue the vision of the Sustainable Development Goals. Ahmedabad, DKesh Deepakbhai Khmar, who runs Made Easy Overseas Visa Consultancy in Borisana, Gandhinagar, has been cheated of Rs 1.02 crore by a visa agent. In November 2024, DKeshbhai's friend Prakashbhai Solanki introduced him to a person named Urjeet Satchit Kavi. Urjeet was working in issuing PR visas with jobs in Australia,

USA and Canada. Dikeshbhai had a meeting with Urjit for the visas of 10 of his clients. On November 24, 2024, he sent the clients' passports and other documents to Urjit through WhatsApp. Urjit asked Dikeshbhai to give him money in installments, which made him trust him. Dikeshbhai gave money to Urjit at different places. Some of the money

was given to his friend Narendrabhai Patel's office at Synergy Space Sargasan. The other amount was given to Urjit's office, Urjit's staff Abhishekbbhai at Vaishnodevi Circle, and Sadaf Paviyria at Thalje. In total, Dikeshbhai gave Urjit one crore two lakh five thousand four hundred rupees. After that, Urjit would call repeatedly and say that only if he gave more work.

Ahmedabad The banned e-cigarette trend, which has been going on for a long time in Ahmedabad, is becoming a serious threat to the health of the younger generation. While the police are conducting raids every day and seizing millions of rupees worth of e-cigarettes, the smugglers have now started online wholesale sales, making this contamination more widespread. Today, on the occasion of 'World Lungs Day', contacted a page on social media that is selling these e-cigarettes online, which are responsible for lung cancer,

and exposed how the contamination of e-cigarettes is being spread at home. Had a conversation on social media with an online seller of e-cigarettes, in which it has been revealed that they are being sold openly despite being banned. A message came from the front after following the account of E-Cigarette Hub Official, the dialogue of which is as follows:

The belief that e-cigarettes are not harmful to health is wrong. Today, August 1, is 'World Lungs Day', on this occasion, shocking statistics about lung

cancer have come to light. In Gujarat, lung cancer is found in about 98 men and 78 women per lakh people. Thus, a total of 176 people are suffering from lung cancer. Out of this, 15% of the total cancer cases are lung cancer, the main reason for which is the habit of smoking. While currently, the trend of banned e-cigarettes is also being seen more in Gujarat. There is a belief among the general public that e-cigarettes are not as harmful as tobacco cigarettes, but Apollo Hospital's pulmonologist Dr. Kashmira Zala has called this belief "completely wrong".

Gopal Italia maintained his demand for the complaint. At this time, a verbal altercation was also seen between Mendarda's female PSI S.N. Sonara and Gopal Italia. After Gopal Italia tried to gather the people and disturb the peace, he said, "Then put me in jail." After a protest for about four hours on August 1, Italia and his supporters left the police station late at night.

Excerpts of conversation between Italia and female PSI

PSI: Your investigation is ongoing there, we do not have the authority to investigate this matter. Italia: I'll show you power, but are you willing to investigate? PSI: What is the clause? Italia: Hello, let's start writing, let's write... PSI: Speak up, we will remember. PSI: The issue is diverted without reason, this is not a criminal matter. Italia: Isn't stealing grain a crime? PSI: Whose grain was stolen? Italia: Of the people. PSI: So you don't know the law.

Italia: It's a matter of food and police. PSI: Under which section can the police investigate? Italia: Ben, if we tell you all the verses, wouldn't you be able to do it? 'Instead of two months, they give only half a month's worth of food grains' Gopal Italia said that Aam Aadmi Party district president Hareesh Savaliya had received information from local villages that in many villages, the food grains available at ration shops are not being given in full. People are being asked twice for two months' ration, but the food grains were given only for half a month. When someone raises their voice on this issue, they are threatened with cancellation of their ration cards. Villagers also staged a sit-in protest at Visavdar police station along with MLA Italia. 'Grains are not given by taking thumbprints, mafia forces them'

He further said that many customers are not given full ration rights even after taking thumbprints. The mafia puts pressure on the supply branch and dealers. Instead of some licensed dealers, mafia men run shops. The system up to the Mamlatdar office is also irresponsible, Gopal Italia alleged. 'The law books are

full, but the police do not get pens' The MLA, who was sitting on a dharna to file a police complaint against the grain mafia, said, "We are sitting on a dharna here because the police say they do not get pens. The law books of Gujarat are worth five hundred kilos, but if we want to register a crime against the mafia stealing the food grains of the poor, the police raise their hands. The Mamlatdar blames the collector. The collector blames the supply officer and the officers say that I have just come and the entire system blames each other." Villagers are raising their voices and are being threatened with cancellation of ration cards. 'Food mafias run with the support of BJP' Gopal Italia accused the ruling party and said that this entire mafia is running under the open support of BJP. For this reason, no one in the police and administration has the courage to take action. While food grains worth crores of rupees are being sold in bulk instead of going to the mouths of the poor. When villagers raise their voices, threats are given to cancel ration cards.

Editorial

Road Safety

Hit and run is caused by the poor driving/judgment of the driver to leave the scene of the accident and escape his/her responsibilities. Serious accidents occurring on road are a matter of great concern for all of us. Not a day passes when we do not read report of at least 2 or 3 serious Hit & Run incidents. It seems our society grows more inclined to accepting self preservation taking precedence over personal responsibility; we are not as horrified as we should be at the commonality of hit and run accidents. Further Hit & run accidents often end up unresolved due to lack of defendants to be indicted for it. It is clear that unless urgent remedial measures are taken, the occurrence of these accidents and resultant casualties will go on rising. It is a problem with a serious enforcement problem, and until the legislature and courts begin to penalize such drivers 'before' they kill someone, law enforcement will continue to consider this a minor infraction.

The law says that if a driver is involved in an accident and damage is caused to people, vehicles, animals or property, they have to stop and provide their name, address and vehicle registration to anyone having reasonable grounds for requiring them. If they don't give their name and address at the time of the collision, they must report it to the Police "as soon as reasonably practicable" but, in any event, within 24 hours. If injury is caused to another person, the driver must also show an insurance certificate; if unable to do so at the scene, (s)he must report the accident to police within 24 hours, and take the certificate to a police station within seven days. The central government intends to convert 52,000 km of state highways into national highways. The upgrade - without instituting adequate safety measures on and along

the national highways - would be undesirable, because the accidents and deaths on national highways exceeds every year with those on the state highways. Hazard identification and control are essential. The true costs of accidents are rarely assessed, and can only be of full value if assessed to formulate future projections of loss probability and effective safety management. It seems as if no one is interested in striking at the root of the traffic problems: poor driver education. The road users should avoid driving recklessly. The other example of neglecting while driving or riding are using hand phone while driving, driving when you are sleepy, driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol and playing loud music while driving. All of this reckless act can be overcome by taking some steps such as use Bluetooth phone devices when receiving or making a call while driving. If the authorities are interested in proper traffic management, the RTOs need to be modernised and upgraded.

It is noticed that the high number of underage drivers transgressing the law by going for a joyride can be attributed to peer pressure and a feeling of youthful invincibility. Youngsters have a sense that they can get away with transgressions - a feeling of bravado whereby "I can get away with anything" but they are not at fault. The parents should be responsible enough not to allow an underage child to drive. Children, by nature, are more reckless. They are not mature enough to understand the consequences of their actions or mistakes. To address these dangers we need to understand the dangers of underage driving. The best possible way to address this road safety hazard is to provide road safety education to both children and parents.

India Records Highest Average Cost of a Data Breach

Ahmedabad, IBM today released its Cost of a Data Breach Report, which revealed the average total organizational cost of data breach in India reached an all-time high of INR 220 million in 2025 (13% higher than last year). The report also found that globally, AI adoption is greatly outpacing AI security and governance. While the overall number of organizations globally experiencing an AI-related breach is a small representation of the researched population, this is the first time security, governance and access controls for AI have been studied in this report, which suggests AI is already an easy, high value target.

Only 37% of organizations reported having AI access controls in place in India, Nearly 60% of organizations

either don't have AI governance policies in place or are still developing them in India. This year's results show that organizations are bypassing security and governance for AI in favor of do-it-now AI adoption. Globally, ungoverned systems are more likely to be breached, and more costly when they are. "India's accelerating AI adoption brings immense opportunity, but it's also exposing enterprises to new and complex cyber threats. The report revealed a gap, while AI is being rapidly embedded across business operations, security and governance are being left behind. The absence of access controls and AI governance tools are not just a technical oversight, it's a strategic vulnerability. CISOs must act decisively - embedding trust, transparency, and governance into AI systems by design," said Viswanath Ramaswamy, Vice President, Technology, IBM India & South Asia. AI Governance Policies: Nearly 60% of breached organizations either don't have an AI governance policy or are still developing a policy. Of the organizations that have AI governance policies in place, only 34% use AI governance technology. (20-4)

On Raksha Bandhan, the sister ties a rakhi, comprising sacred threads, on her brother's wrist and performs an aarati. While tying the rakhi, the girls chant "Yena baddho Balee raajaa daanavendro mahaabalah tena twaam anubadhaami rakshe maa chala maa chala"

Means "I am tying a Rakhi on you, like the one on mighty demon king Bali. Be firm, O Rakhi, do not falter." It is the duty of every brother to protect his sister. The sister prays for the well-being, success, and safety of her brother. The brother promises to safeguard his sister under all circumstances. It helps to build a healthy family relationship. Today, the festival goes much beyond real brothers and sisters to any two individuals who enjoy a deep relationship. So you are likely to see a woman tie a rakhi to her cousins, neighbours and close friends. The love and self actuation

towards a novel cause between a brother and his sister is the theme of this great Rakhi festival.

Thus Raksha Bandhan, like all other Indian festivals, is a call to the Divine Self within. So let us pledge, on this day, to commit ourselves to dedicating our actions to our goal of self-betterment, harbouring finer emotions and developing the clarity to see the permanence in and through the transience of the world.

West Asia on the boil: The strategic fallout of Israel-Iran clashes

The recent attack and counter-attack between Israel and Iran have widened the scope of the conflict in West Asia. The long-simmering tension between them conflagrated into a condition that bordered on a full-blown war. The US and Israel's collaboration in dismantling Iranian nuclear facilities through the use of critical and cutting-edge technology from the air has inflicted considerable damage on Iran. It is difficult to assess the scope and nature of the damage to the nuclear facilities in an authoritarian

country, where everything is guarded closely and access to information is not a right. Iran's clandestine pursuit of nuclear enrichment in deep underground facilities makes it difficult to determine the gravity of damage. However, Iran threatens to attack American military bases in the region. Therefore, the recent hiatus is short-lived or a sort of preparation for something consequential in the near future. The cycle of violence has already begun, and it may intensify sooner or later to a different level. Every move has seen a countermove in the

past. For instance, Israel's attack on Iran's nuclear and military sites coincided with the latter's attack on Tel Aviv and Haifa—critical areas from security, civilian, commercial, and defence perspectives. Israel's impregnable air defence system, known as Iron Dome, was penetrated by Iranian missiles, causing considerable damage. These developments sent shockwaves worldwide concerning their possible escalation and concomitant ramifications. The potential global economic consequences of a full-scale

war—or even the persistence of the ongoing conflict—will have significant geopolitical implications for the region and beyond. To understand the character of the conflict, the following aspects assume salience: Geographical Non-Contiguity

Israel and Iran do not share a common border. This geographical factor is a war-negative factor. Missile exchanges between the two countries are not new. Iran has disproportionately carried out air attacks on Israel in the past. Israel's Iron Dome has

usually prevented destruction. Tel Aviv has consistently directed its efforts to thwart Iran's resolve to build a nuclear warhead. The former strikes the latter's nuclear facilities to prevent the completion and test-firing of a nuclear bomb. Israel perceives an existential threat from Iran, which is determined to destroy Israel for ideological and religious reasons. Geography is a significant deterrent. Iran

uses Iraqi and Jordanian airspace to attack Israel. Israel also uses Syrian and Iraqi airspace to carry out air offensives against Iran. Aerial war using other nations' airspace is untenable and expensive in the long run. Air defence and AI-based disabling technology may render missiles imprecise and erratic. Israel has reportedly taken control of Iranian airspace, posing an enormous challenge to Iranian air power.
